



Primum Suffragium – “First Vote”

Over the next month or so the PIPOA community has a decision to make. That decision being who to select to fill 2 PIPOA Board seats.

The Annual Members Meeting is on March 9th and ballots should already be in the mail. For each property you own you can select up to two candidates. There are five candidates standing for election, including myself.

Qualities you wish to see in a Board Member are entirely up to you. And I hope that each candidate provides enough information about themselves and their goals as a Board Member so you can make an informed decision. I know I will provide my goals and try to answer any questions you might have.

The Board considers many issues and casts many votes during their term. Important issues are generally known in the community and listed in the agenda for upcoming Board Meetings if a Board vote is anticipated. This process gives Members of the PIPOA the ability to talk with Board Members and provide input and opinions.

But there is one vote that is different. That being the first vote taken by a newly elected Board Member.

Per our Bylaws, immediately following the Annual Members Meeting is the Annual Board Meeting. And the only item on the agenda is the election of Board Officers. There is no time for a newly elected Board Member to take input from the community about the Officer vote. The vote will happen within minutes of the release of the election results.

So, if who is selected for Board Officers is important to you, then your opportunity to ask the candidates is prior to the election.

And to save you some time, I will answer that question now. If elected I will support current Board President Marvin Jones.

Like many of you, I have not agreed with every single decision that has come from this Board and I wish that some changes were happening faster. But I am happy with the leadership that President Jones has provided. Progress has been made and I wish this leadership to continue and finish the job it has started. And I hope, if elected, that I can work with all Board Members to achieve the goals I have offered in my candidate statement.
